Rules & Regulations

40 Boat Maximum Field

Tournament Hours 7 am - 3 pm

**Pre-Tournament meeting 6:15 am at the
Four Seasons Resort, Miscauno Island.**

Boat Positions will be assigned in the order that entries are received.

Check-In; Four seasons Boat Dock:

All boats must be checked in and inspected; Live wells are required. DNR and boat safety rules apply.

Weigh In: Four Seasons Boat Dock on the west side of Miscauno Island, just south of the boat landing and bridge.

Eligibility: Any person, age 16 or under must be a team partner with a parent or a person over the age of 18. Persons under the age of 18 must have the signature of his/her parent or legal guardian on the tournament entry form.

Sportsmanship: All teams are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, safety, courtesy and conservation. Any team who violates these rules or any federal, state or local laws will be disqualified. All tournament boats must refrain from fishing 50 yards from another boat. Courtesy must be given to both tournament and non-tournament boats.

No alcohol in boats during tournament hours.

Communication: No physical contact between Boats. Boaters may leave there boat at the Tournament Headquarters. Any boat leaving there boat for any reason will be disqualified.

Take-off: Boats will take-off in an orderly manor, according to the assigned boat number. Further instructions will be given at the pre tournament meeting.

Off Limits: The area directly in front of the Four Seasons Boat Dock and the adjacent bridge are off limitd during tournament hours.

Bass Tournament Scoring: Each boat may weigh in a combined limit of 5 smallmouth or largemouth bass at least 14". Fish will be measured on a Golden Rule with the mouth closed and tail compressed or fanned. Only live fish will be weighed. All fish must be released.

Tackle & Equipment: Only artificial lures with the exception of pork rind may be used. Only one rod and reel combination may be used at one time per person. Trolling is prohibited.

Boundaries: Fishing will be allowed from the Chalk Hills Dam, upstream to Pemenee Rapids.
