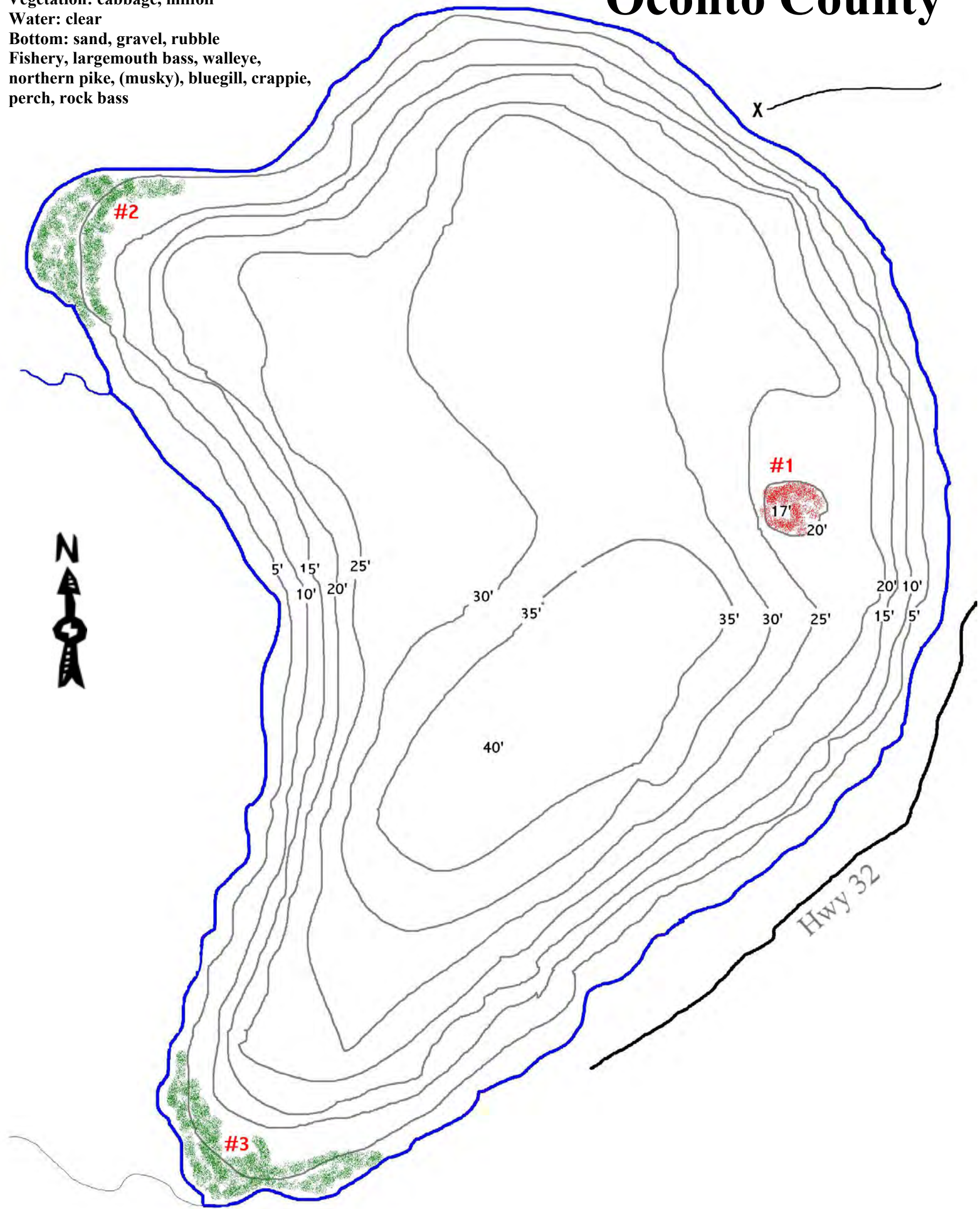


Anderson Lake
182 acres max depth 40'

Vegetation: cabbage, milfoil
Water: clear
Bottom: sand, gravel, rubble
Fishery, largemouth bass, walleye,
northern pike, (musky), bluegill, crappie,
perch, rock bass

Anderson Lake Oconto County



- #1** This deep hump is the only walleye structure in the lake. In summer, drift live bait rigs tipped with crawlers and leeches. In fall, use a jig and minnow.
- #2** In spring fish the shallows for largemouth bass, northern pike and panfish. All species move out along the weedline in summer.
- #3** Another early season hot spot for largemouth bass, panfish and northern pike. The weedline is good for summer and fall largemouth.
