


Leigh Lake

Oconto County

- #1 Largemouth move into the bay in spring, and due to the deep water, they can remain in the bay through October. Start with a spinnerbait then switch to a soft plastic jerkbait or a jig. In summer and fall fish the edge of the bay for largemouth and panfish.
- #2 Try plastics for a big largemouth late May through June.
- #3 This main lake point and adjacent wood attracts feeding largemouth from June through November. Use plastics on the point but use crankbaits in deeper water for suspended largemouth.
- #4 Cast crankbaits over the submerged wood and fish plastics tight to the wood for summer & fall largemouth
